The *Upper Room Handbook on Emmaus* “Chapter 4—Team Selection: Team Selection Guidelines: Progressive Servanthood” states the following:

The purpose of an established progression of responsibilities for Emmaus community members is twofold: leadership training and spiritual development. A person’s readiness to carry out his or her particular assignment effectively often depends on and is always enhanced by prior experience in another position. The progression of responsibilities starts with support roles (agape, kitchen, set-up) and then moves into the conference room. Entry positions for the Conference Room Team are either Assistant Table Leader (and possibly speaker) or Table Leader (and possibly speaker). Experience in both positions is necessary before progressing to Assistant Lay Director. The position of Lay director is for those who have served at least twice as an Assistant Lay Director.

In addition to preparing person for Emmaus leadership, progressive team assignments train persons in the posture and practice of humble servanthood and the heart of true Christian leadership.

Please join the BOerNe AGAIN Emmaus 4<sup>th</sup> Day Community Board of Directors in an effort to discern the Holy Spirit’s will in the selection of a Lay Director for a Walk to Emmaus weekend. In order for this application to be reviewed impartially, please follow the guidelines outlined.

1. Provide a separate cover page with your name, address, city, state and zip code; your email address; your phone numbers: home, work, cell; your home church name, denomination, and city; your pilgrim walk number, date and location; your group reunion name, meeting day and time; and your 4<sup>th</sup> Day community name, location and city.
